

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS CHECKLIST

(for students requesting Form I-20)

- 1. Completed Application.
- 2. If a spouse or child(ren) will be accompanying student, the applicant must fill out the family information on the application form.
- 3. US\$100 non-refundable application fee.
- 4. Tuition payment made payable to *Selnate International School* (at least first semester's payment).
- 5. Recent (no more than sixty days old), official bank statement showing a minimum of US\$12,000 for 2 semesters (plus US\$1600 each for spouse & children).
- 6. If a sponsor is supporting the applicant, the sponsor must complete and sign the affidavit of support and send a recent (no more than sixty days old) official bank statement showing amounts in item 4.
- 7. Copy of passport page(s) that shows name, passport expiration date, birth date, and citizenship.
- 8. If applicant is in the United States, a copy of the visa page, I-94 card (received at port of entry), Form I-20 from current school, and a completed transfer form.

IMPORTANT! Selnate reserves the right to determine classes, levels, and schedules for all students. • Tuition and fees are subject to change without notice. Selnate accepts debit/ATM, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover cards. • Tuition and application fee **must** be received before Form I-20 will be sent. • Homestay and application fees are non-refundable beyond three (3) business days of receipt. • *Tuition refund policy:* After Selnate issues the Form I-20, if the student is unable to attend Selnate for any reason other than visa denial, the student must notify Selnate in writing at least 30 days before the beginning of the semester to receive a tuition refund. If Selnate is not notified at least 30 days before the semester begins, no refund will be made. If the visa is denied, the student is eligible for a full tuition refund. Tuition will not be refunded to students who withdraw from their studies after a semester begins. Tuition refunds will not be granted to students who are expelled from Selnate for violation of policies or standards. • *Homestay fees refund policy:* Homestay fees are calculated on a weekly basis. Selnate will refund homestay fees on a prorated basis for unused weeks, provided the student gives at least a two (2) week notice to school administration. If less than (2) weeks notice is given, the minimum 2 weeks notice shall be added to the cancellation date and the refund adjusted accordingly.

Go to visa interview and pay fee

Receive visa (usually takes 3-7 days)

Fly to Salt Lake City, Utah

Come to Selnate 3~5 days before first day of class for testing

HOMESTAY:

Benefits and Details

- Placement with a local, English-speaking family
- 3 meals per day, 7 days per week
- Private bedroom with quiet study area
- Transportation not included; all families within 30-40 minute bus ride of school
- Optional: \$60/month (approx) bus pass
- Inclusion in family activities
- Learn culture first-hand from an American family
- Ability to help select own family from wide selection of families—satisfaction guaranteed
- Ability to change families at beginning of each calendar month for any reason
- Ability to change families immediately in case of emergency
- All utilities (except long-distance phone charges) included

APARTMENT:

Benefits and Details

- Housing within walking distance in most cases
- Socialization with other college students
- Choose between shared or private room
- Furnishings: Most fully furnished
- Most nearby housing BYU-approved, which means students must abide by BYU Honor Code (*See <http://honorcode.byu.edu/> for more information.*)

Cost

Prices: \$260-\$350/month for shared rooms
 \$300-\$450/month for private rooms
(Summer months are cheaper)

Utilities: About \$50/person/month

Meals: Not included; students generally spend \$150-\$400/month on food
