RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Students joining these classes must not require an I-20.
2. Student must understand clearly that they are joining a semester in-progress, and therefore the teacher is not expected to repeat information already covered earlier in the program.
3. Selnate will coordinate with the student to ensure the student is placed in the level which best approximates his/her level at the time classes start.
4. Student understands that classes run Monday-Thursday, except for holidays and breaks as shown on the current calendar.
5. Students must enter the US on an F-1 Student Visa if they are to study 4 hours or more per day. Students entering on almost any other visa (including tourist) are only eligible to study 3 classes or less per day as per USCIS (immigration) rules.
6. Unless noted otherwise, all paid students (regardless of visa and program type) are eligible to participate in weekly activities and may use computer lab without charge.
